What is a Right of Interment?

A plot is referred to as a Right of Interment.

The Right of Interment is only the right to permit a burial in that place, it does not include the purchase of the actual piece of land (which is not permitted).

Only the Holder(s) of the Right of Interment can grant permission for interments (burials) and give permission for any memorial or plaque.

Monuments, Memorials and Adornments

All plot monuments, memorials, plaques, and adornments must conform with the Rules & Regulations set by the Kangaroo Ground Cemetery Trust and must be approved in writing in advance.

The Rules & Regulations are issued with this document and are also available at www.kangaroogroundcemetery.com.au.

By signing the Right of Interment Form A, the Applicant agrees that all Holders of Right of Interment will adhere to the Rules & Regulations set by the Kangaroo Ground Cemetery Trust.

Pricing

Prices are applicable from 1st July 2024. All Rights of Interment (plots) are GST free. All other fees are quoted inclusive of GST.

This price list is approved and published in accordance with Government guidelines.

Plot Selection

PRICE LIST

Monumental Right of Interment (plot)

Monumental plots are suitable for 2 full burials and up to 3 ashes interments.
Only 1 set of ashes may be interred prior to the full burials.
Alternatively, 4 sets of ashes may be interred if no full burials are required.

Full monuments or headstones may be installed with written approval on these plots, in accordance with the Rules & Regulations.

Personal Selection (PS) Right of Interment -	Right of Interment	\$3,085.00

Right of Interment for monumental plots may be purchased in advance or at the time of need.

The transfer of Right of Interment is completed when full payment and a signed Right of Interment Form A has been received.

Graveside & Cemetery Services Fees payable at the time of burial arrangement (GST incl.)

Preparation of grave site, digging, backfilling (on the day), backfilling (as required over time), funeral day supervision and witnessing. Cemetery administration and recording.

Services, as stated above, coffins that are not wider than 629mm	\$2,290.00
Services, as stated above, oversize coffins 630mm or wider (OS)	\$2,730.00

2nd interments in a monumental plot may incur an additional fee of between \$295 and \$1,320 for inspection, and ledger (lid) removal/replacement if required.

This will be advised at the time of need, depending on the type of memorial on the grave.

Total Cost at time of need if Right of Interment is not pre-purchased:

Monumental Right of Interment and 1 st burial:	\$5,080.00 or \$5,375.00	Personal Selection
Monumental Right of Interment and 1 st burial (OS):	\$5,520.00 or \$5,815.00	Personal Selection

Full payment and the signed Right of Interment Form A are required prior to the burial.
The fees and paperwork may also be done through your funeral arranger.

Grass Lawn Right of Interment (plot)

Grass Lawn plots are suitable for 2 full burials and up to 2 ashes interments.
Only 1 set of ashes may be interred prior to the full burials.
Alternatively, 4 sets of ashes may be interred if no full burials are required.

Plaques may be installed with permission on these plots, in accordance with the Rules & Regulations. No other adornment is permitted.

Personal Selection (PS) Right of Interment -	Right of Interment	\$2,685.00

Right of Interment for grass lawn plots may be purchased in advance or at the time of need.

The transfer of Right of Interment is completed when full payment and a signed Right of Interment Form A has been received.

Graveside & cemetery services fees payable at the time of burial arrangement (GST incl.)

Preparation of grave site, digging, backfilling (on the day), backfilling (as required over time), funeral day supervision and witnessing. Cemetery administration and recording.

Ashes Only Interment (plot) Options

Double Ashes Right of Interment (plot)

Double Ashes Plots are suitable for 2 sets of ashes interments in perpetuity (forever).

A maximum of 2 plaques may be installed with written approval on these plots, in accordance with the Rules & Regulations. No other adornment is permitted.

Next available Right of Interment (allocated) -	Right of Interment	\$1,420.00
Personal Selection (PS) Right of Interment -	Right of Interment	\$1,710.00

Right of Interment for double ashes plots may be purchased in advance or at the time of need.

The transfer of Right of Interment is completed when full payment and a signed Right of Interment Form A has been received.

A personalised bronze plaque typically costs from \$1,750 to \$2,900 depending on the design.

25 Years Double Ashes Right of Interment (plot)

A 25 years' double plot is suitable for ashes interments for 25 years.

The ashes will be removed and scattered 25 years after the 2nd set of ashes is interred, if applicable. Any plaques will also be removed at this time.

A maximum of 2 plaques may be installed with written approval on these plots, in accordance with the Rules & Regulations. No other adornment is permitted.

Right of Interment for 25 years ashes plots may be purchased in advance or at the time of need.

It is not possible to personally select a 25 year only plot. It will be allocated by the Cemetery.

The transfer of Right of Interment is completed when full payment and a signed Right of Interment Form A has been received.

A personalised bronze plaque typically costs from \$1,750 to \$2,900 depending on the design.

Rock Garden Ashes Right of Interment (plot): 1 set of ashes

A Rock Garden Ashes plot may have a 152mm² plaque installed, with written approval, in accordance with the Rules & Regulations. No other adornment is permitted.

Next available Right of Interment (allocated) -	Perpetual	\$1,840.00
Personal Selection (PS) Right of Interment -	Perpetual	\$2,130.00

Right of Interment for rock garden ashes plots may be purchased in advance or at the time of need.

The transfer of Right of Interment is completed when full payment and a signed Right of Interment Form A has been received.

Rock Garden Ashes plots are for 1 set of ashes and are only suitable for perpetual use. A single rock may have multiple plots on it which may be bought together or individually.

A personalised bronze plaque 152mm square typically costs approximately \$1280 depending on the design.

Cemetery Fee for ashes interments, per set of ashes

Payable at the time of the arrangement, prior to burial

Interment of Ashes, per set - perpetual and 25 years	\$280.00
Interment of Ashes, per set, with family/friends in attendance by appointment 7.30am-1.30pm Monday to Thursday, perpetual and 25 years	\$845.00
Interment of Ashes, with family/friends in attendance by appointment, subject to availability, outside of the above hours, perpetual and 25 years	\$1,120.00

Full payment and the signed Interment Form B (per set) are required prior to the interment.

The fees and paperwork may also be done through your funeral arranger.

It is a criminal offense to inter or scatter ashes within Cemetery Grounds without prior consent.

Kangaroo Ground Public Cemetery has a published history of the cemetery 1851-2001, The First 150 Years, 'Tread Softly, You Tread on Dreams' written by Mr Mick Woiwod, which is available from the cemetery, by arrangement, for \$15. The proceeds of this book go towards the restoration of very old monuments within the cemetery.
